New in August 2026: **Online Meeting Mastery** is a shorter, standalone “exploration” (\$15 USD) rather than a full path — its three projects are marked NEW below and earn Level 2-equivalent DCP credit.

- Toastmaster ×2
- Evaluator ×2
- One more: TT Speaker, TT Master, Ah-Counter, Timer, Grammarian, Club Mentor, Specialized Role, or repeat a role above
